It is a very special experience to drive a few meters past a full-grown bear on a motorbike, thrills are guaranteed. As well-known as the Transfăgărăşan and the Transalpina are, the routes we drive to reach them are just as unknown and only known to us as insiders.

On this tour we will also visit Sibiu (Hermanstadt) in the geographic center of Romania and Sighişoara (Schäßburg), one of the most important cities in Mureş County because of its unique historical center.

So that you can really enjoy your trip and travel light, we offer you a free, dry and secure luggage depot at our APUSENI LODGE Romania[®].



Requirements

- Good physical condition and stamina (average driving time of 5 hours per day)
- Safe driving in the rain (we drive in almost any weather)
- Perfect condition of the vehicle and the tires
- Also suitable for new drivers and beginners with sufficient driving experience







Day 1

We start at 09:00 am from APUSENI LODGE Romania® and drive through the Apuseni Mountains on winding roads. Even this first 230 km long stage gives an idea of what we can look forward to in the next few days. At our stage destination you have the opportunity to explore the Peştera Urşilor Chişcău (Bear's Cave) on your own (depending on the local sightseeing offer).

Day 2

Today's destination is Alba Iulia (Karlsburg), the capital of Alba County in the Transylvania region. On the way there we will show you u. a. one of our favorite secret canyons and you can see your fill of the beautiful nature of Romania. In the evening you relax in a beautiful upscale hotel.

Day 3

Day three has a few surprises in store. Through another gorge (there are countless of them in Romania, you just have to find them) you go over the first part of the Transalpina to charming Sibiu (Hermannstadt), which lies in the geographical center of Romania. So we have arrived in the Southern Carpathians. Sibiu is ideal for strolling around the beautiful market square and for shopping in the numerous shops.

Day 4

On winding detours we drive around 200 kilometers via Sighișoara (Schäßburg) to Făgăraș in the district of Brașov, near the entrance to the Transfăgărășan, which we want to cycle the next day. Depending on the travel speed of the group, we can take a longer break in Sighisoara and watch the hustle and bustle on the market square.

Chişcău - Alba Iulia approx. 192 km

Day 3

Alba Iulia - Sibiu approx. 202 km

Day 4

Slbiu - Făgăraș approx. 208 km

Day 5

Făgăraș - Râmnicu Vâlcea approx. 193 km

Day 6

Râmnicu Vâlcea - Region Târgu Jiu approx. 205 km

Day 7

Region Târgu Jiu - Avram Iancu approx. 251 km





Day 5

It is before us, the Transfăgărăşan! Hopefully the bears got up early enough and are waiting for us at the roadside. In any case, we keep our eyes open and if we see a vehicle with its hazard lights on, we can almost be sure that we will see a Carpathian bear shortly afterwards. On the Transfăgărăşan you have to be careful, stay behind the tour guide and strictly follow his instructions! Because even if the bears only sit here to be fed from passing vehicles, they remain wild, unpredictable, fast and extremely strong original inhabitants of the Romanian forests.

Day 6

The Transalpina, also known as Drum naţional 67C, is the highest mountain pass in Romania. It crosses the Transylvanian Alps, connects Gorj County in Lesser Wallachia with Alba County in Transylvania and reaches an altitude of just over 2100m. We drive this magnificent panoramic road today! It can stay chilly up here even in summer, so don't just dress warm for the amazing experience. In the evening we reach the Târgu Jiu region and end the day as usual in comfortable accommodation.

Day 7

The adventure is not over yet, because even the last 250 km of our trip make the biker's heart beat faster. Back at the APUSENI LODGE Romania®, you can pick up any luggage you may have left and, if you have the time and leisure, review the past few days at our campfire.


